1. LECTURESHIP/SENIOR LECTURESHIP/ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP (I POST)

Department of Nursing & Midwifery Sciences

Applicants must have a relevant First Degree and a Master of Science Degree in Nursing/Midwifery or equivalent qualifications. A PhD qualification and experience and interest in teaching and research will be added advantages. The applicants must be self motivated and willing to work with a dynamic team. Further, they must be registered with the Nurses Council of Zimbabwe and must have a current practicing certificate.

2. LECTURESHIP/SENIOR LECTURESHIP/ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP (3 POSTS)

Department of Paediatrics

Applicants must be holders of a minimum qualification of an MBBS or MBChB or equivalent and a relevant Master's Degree and/or specialist qualification such as M.Med, FRCP, FCP, or equivalent. A PhD qualification or sub speciality qualification such as Paediatric Pulmonology, Neurology, Neonatology and Nephrology; plus teaching and research experience will be added advantages. The successful applicants must be registrable on the Specialist Register of the Medical and Dental Practitioners Council of Zimbabwe (MDPCZ). In addition, they must be self motivated and willing to work with a dynamic team. Further, they must have a current practicing certificate.

3. LECTURESHIP/SENIOR LECTURESHIP/ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP (2 POSTS)

Department of Psychiatry, Social and Behavioural Sciences

Applicants must hold a minimum qualification of a relevant Master's Degree and/or qualifications such as MA in Social and Behavioural Sciences, MPH (Generalist) or equivalent. A PhD qualification, as well as a proven teaching or research background would be added advantages. In addition, the successful applicants must be self motivated and willing to work with a small, but dynamic team.

4. LECTURESHIP/SENIOR LECTURESHIP/ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP (I POST)

Department of Community Medicine

Applicants must be in possession of a minimum qualification of a relevant PhD Degree, Master's Degree and/or specialist qualification such as M.Med, or similar and registrable on the specialist register of the Medical and Dental Practitioners of Zimbabwe. Teaching and research experience will be an added advantage. Applicants will be drawn from Family Medicine.

5. LECTURESHIP/SENIOR LECTURESHIP/ASSOCIATE PROFESSORSHIP (4 POSTS)

Department of Anatomy and Physiology

POST A: PHYSIOLOGY (2 POSTS)

POST B: ANATOMY (2 POSTS)
