- Ensure teaching is informed by contemporary research in the relevant field and develop the ability of students to engage in debate, critical discourse and rational thinking

- Evaluate the effectiveness of learning, teaching and assessment performance against professional and national standards
- Engage in and contribute to the development and delivery of interdisciplinary learning, teaching and assessment.
- Use appropriate learning resources effectively
- Undertake and coordinate field research on development and disaster management issues
- Supervise student research projects.
